## The Circle (or Cycle) below is intended to aid in memorizing the order of sharps and flats in major key signatures.

- 1. Start at "C" at the top, which represents the key of C Major with no sharps or flats.
- 2. Move around the circle to the right, toward "F" to cycle through the keys with flats. i.e. The key of F Major has one (1) flat.
- 3. Move around the circle to the left, toward "G" to cycle through the keys with sharps. i.e. The key of G Major has one (1) sharp.
- 4. Use the sentences below to memorize the order of sharps and flats as they appear in the major key signatures. The first letter of each word represents a sharp or flat found in the key signature.
- 5. Take notice that the sentences are the same forward and backward!
